

Class of 2015 Reunion



2024 NCEA Results

Cashmere High School students achieved some outstanding academic results in the 2024 NCEA exams, with Cashmere High School once again outperforming the national averages across all three levels of NCEA.



These great results mirror the results of previous years, and are testament to the combined commitment and effort of staff and students. Note that some schools have withdrawn from NCEA Level 1.

In Memoriam - Ann McKenna

Former pupil and staff member, Ann McKenna (née Colville) passed away on January 24th, 2025, in Nelson.

Ann attended Cashmere High School from 1957 to 1961, and in 1961 was a prefect and Captain of the Girls Hockey XI. She returned to CHS as a science teacher from 1966 to 1969, and again in 1978 until 1985. During this time she also coached the girls' hockey team.

Ann was an outstanding cricketer and field hockey player. She was a Canterbury representative in hockey during the 60s and 70s, and represented NZ in 1967 and 1971. She was assistant coach of the NZ Women's Hockey Team from 1988 to 1992. In cricket, Ann represented Canterbury between 1962 and 1988, and 1991. She was a NZ representative in cricket in 1969, 1984 and 1985-1987. In 1982 she coached the NZ U23 Women's team, and coached the NZ Women's cricket team from 1992 to 1997. From 1993 to 1994 she was the NZ Cricket Coaching Director for Women's Cricket.

The Foundation extends their heartfelt sympathies to Ann's family.
